

Makua Agreement School Year 2023-2024

As an 'ohana of Kūlaniākea we agree to the following:

- To participate in *ALL* classroom and home activities as planned and assigned by Kumu to support my keiki's whole development. Examples of activities may be but not limited to: literacy program with completed reading logs; Hawaiian language support through home activities; practicing Hawaiian language with keiki and building Hawaiian vocabulary etc.
- As my keiki's first kumu, and an extension of Kūlaniākea, my household will practice and include on a daily and consistent basis, Hawaiian language, Hawaiian values and cultural practices as used by the program (aloha, ha'a ha'a, 'ohana, ho'oponopono etc.).
- Support the philosophy of Kūlaniākea as outlined in the 'Ohana Handbook, Curriculum Guide, and as practiced in the classroom.
- To attend *ALL* school functions planned for keiki and 'ohana by Kūlaniākea and Hui Makua. If we are unable to attend, we will arrange to have extended 'ohana participation in our place with our keiki as my 'ohana will benefit from the experience (Grandparents, uncles, aunts, friends, caregivers and other 'ohana Kūlaniākea).
- We understand the active involvement of each school 'ohana is key in strengthening our 'ohana relationship with kula and the community. We also understand that our participation in school activities is not only mandatory but provide a role model to our keiki, the importance of working together as an extended 'ohana and allows them the opportunity to see how we value their educational environment.

If our 'ohana is unable to fulfill our kuleana as described in this agreement, we will meet with our Kumu and Administration to insure this is an appropriate fit for keiki, mākua and kula.
