

## PAPAHANA KUAOLA SUPPLY LIST 2023 – 2024

All of the items listed below are required and separate from your classroom supplies.

### LABELED WITH KEIKI NAME

- Lole 'au (Swimwear arrive with it on)
- Kalipa (Rubber slippers, no sneakers, sandals, etc. arrive with it on)
- 'Eke Kua (Backpack: manage to carry, open / shut themselves), with the following items inside:
  - **o** Kāwele (Towel)
  - o Lole Keu (Extra set of clothing: shirt, shorts, underwear)
  - o 'Ōmole wai (Water flask filled)
  - o 1 Hāli'i (Fitted Crib Sheet)
  - o 1 Kapa moe (Light blanket or pareo choose 1)
  - o 1 Lakeke Ua (Rain Jacket)
  - o 1 'Eke Pulu (Wet Bag)
- Kāma'a puki (Rubber Boots attached to backpack with carabiner)

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- ⇒ Boots should be attached outside to keiki backpack with a carabiner.
- $\Rightarrow$  Sunscreen and mosquito repellant applied at home.
- $\Rightarrow$  Staff is not responsible for unlabeled items.

### ARRIVAL & PROTOCOL

# **SAFETY ALERT!**

• Keiki must be supervised by makua when not in the direct care of kumu. This is an important safety rule, particularly at drop-off and pick up.

- Makua and keiki must practice the appropriate response when their name is called. The appropriate response is as follows:
  - o Makua calls keiki by name
  - o Keiki stops
  - o Keiki turns to look at makua
  - o Keiki responds with "EŌ"
- If keiki are unable to demonstrate our safety protocols while on our huaka'i or out in the community, keiki will not be allowed to attend the next huaka'i.
