



PAPAHANA KUAOLA SUPPLY LIST 2023 – 2024

All of the items listed below are required and separate from your classroom supplies.

LABELED WITH KEIKI NAME

- Lole ‘au (Swimwear - arrive with it on)
- Kalipa (Rubber slippers, no sneakers, sandals, etc. - arrive with it on)
- ‘Eke Kua (Backpack: manage to carry, open / shut themselves), with the following items inside:
 - Kāwele (Towel)
 - Lole Keu (Extra set of clothing: shirt, shorts, underwear)
 - ‘Ōmole wai (Water flask - filled)
 - 1 Hāli‘i (Fitted Crib Sheet)
 - 1 Kapa moe (Light blanket or pareo - choose 1)
 - 1 Lakeke Ua (Rain Jacket)
 - 1 ‘Eke Pulu (Wet Bag)
- Kāma‘a puki (Rubber Boots - attached to backpack with carabiner)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- ⇒ Boots should be attached outside to keiki backpack with a carabiner.
- ⇒ Sunscreen and mosquito repellent applied at home.
- ⇒ Staff is not responsible for unlabeled items.

ARRIVAL & PROTOCOL

- **PAPAHANA KUAOLA IS OUR OUTDOOR CLASSROOM. START TIME IS 7:45 AM. KEIKI PARTICIPATE IN MORNING PROTOCOL WITH STAFF OF PAPAHANA KUAOLA.**

SAFETY ALERT!

- **Keiki must be supervised by makua when not in the direct care of kumu. This is an important safety rule, particularly at drop-off and pick up.**

- **Makua and keiki must practice the appropriate response when their name is called. The appropriate response is as follows:**
 - **Makua calls keiki by name**
 - **Keiki stops**
 - **Keiki turns to look at makua**
 - **Keiki responds with “EŌ”**
- **If keiki are unable to demonstrate our safety protocols while on our huaka‘i or out in the community, keiki will not be allowed to attend the next huaka‘i.**
